INTERNAL RULES

As adopted by the General Meeting on 13 June 2012 and amended on [●] 2023

1. Membership

The Association aims for a membership of the largest possible number of members, as defined in the Articles of Association, in order to:

- enhance the opportunities for interfacing with the EU Institutions, other organisations and, national and regional governments;
- provide a mechanism for associating with other organisations.

2. Executive Board

The Association shall strive that all members of the Executive Board are from different companies and from different countries. The Executive Board shall represent the international approach of the Association. Therefore, the Association shall aim to reflect the EU member states by avoiding that single member states are represented by more than two (2) Executive Board members representing companies with their registered office in the same country. However, this general aim is overruled by the electoral freedom of the General Assembly.

3. Chairman / Vice-Chairman(e)n

The Chairman and the Vice-Chairman(e)n of the Association have to be representatives of pharmaceutical companies.

4. Treasurer

The Treasurer is responsible for the finances of the Association.

Annex 1

Annual Membership Fees of EUCOPE AISBL

- According to Article 9 of the Articles of Association -

The annual membership fees are as follows per subcategory of membership:

Institutional Members:

Decisive shall be the annual turnover as defined by the relevant EU provisions (Recommendation 2003/361/EC) or the number of members.

The following thresholds are decisive:

- **Annual turnover up to EUR 10 Mio:**
EUR 5.000 per year
- **Annual turnover turnover > EUR 10 Mio:**
EUR 7.500 per year
- **Annual turnover > EUR 50 Mio:**
EUR 12,000 per year
- **Annual turnover > EUR 500 Mio:**
EUR 18,000 per year
- **Associations with more than 200 members:**
EUR 18,000 per year

Personal Members and Associate Members: EUR 7,500 per person or company/year.
